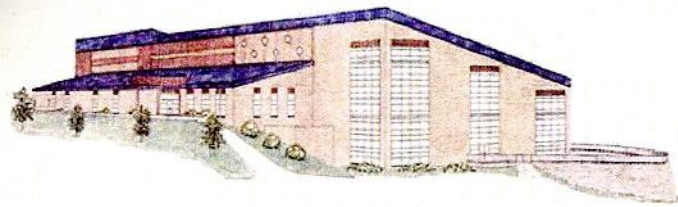

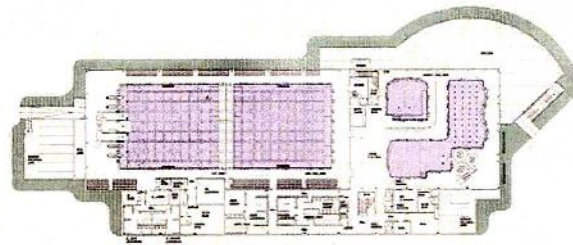

Our *mission* is to operate a public aquatic facility to increase health, wealth, water safety and aquatic education of Christiansburg citizens and aquatic organizations.

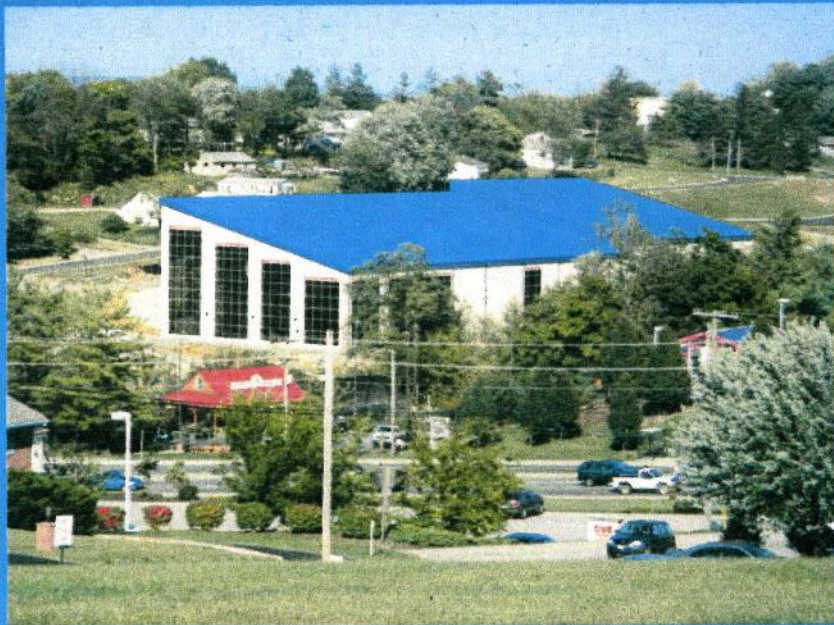
The aquatic center will attract and encourage the entire family to promote healthy lifestyle habits and enjoy several aquatic programs.



The Christiansburg Aquatic Center will be home to a 50 meter competition pool; diving platforms for 1 and 3 meter springboards and a 5, 7 ½ and 10 meter platform; leisure pool with a two story water slide and water features; heated therapy pool; 1,100 seats for spectators; sun deck; locker rooms, family changing areas; wet classrooms; observation deck; administrative offices; fitness areas; warming kitchen; lounge; multi-purpose rooms and Wi-Fi.

The family leisure pool has a beach entry concept that will include a triple loop water slide, spray features and dumping fountain of water buckets. The spa like atmosphere of the heated therapy pool is an ideal amenity for those with arthritic joints, over exerted muscles, rehabilitation or physical therapy programs.
